The use of the euphemism in this context leads to hiding the illegality of the authorities' actions, their immorality. The function lies in hiding information about aggressive or secret military actions on the territory of the Crimea.

The electronic version of The Daily Beast for August 4, 2014 contains the following article headline: USA- Russia Tensions Nuke Plans for Real-Life "Armageddon" Asteroid Defense. In this proposal was found the use of a euphemism nuke, which is denoted in the dictionary as a tactical nuclear weapon.
